



Congressman Mike Thompson visits North Coast

U.S. Rep. Mike Thompson will be in Humboldt County this week to help celebrate the opening of the new Hydrogen Fueling Station at Humboldt State University.

HSU and the Schatz Energy Research Center will host the ribbon-cutting ceremony for the new student-designed Hydrogen Fueling Station and the hydrogen-powered Toyota Prius on Thursday at 11 a.m. at the station site on Rossow Street behind Harry Griffith Hall.

HSU President Rollin Richmond and Schatz Director Peter Lehman will be accompanied by Thompson and Caltrans District One Director Charlie Fielder.

Thompson will also host a meeting with county officials, community leaders and federal agency representatives to discuss the Redwood Creek Levee Project located in Orick. The Community Health Alliance and other medical professionals will update the Congressman on local efforts to improve the quality of health care. He will also tour a local telemedicine clinic in Eureka.

Also on Thursday, Thompson will be at the Community Health Alliance — Health Update at the Humboldt Area Foundation, 373 Indianola Road, in Bayside, from 1:30-2:30 p.m.

On Friday, he will be at the Telehealth and Visiting Specialist Center at 2426 Buhne St., in Eureka, from 8:30-9:30 a.m.
