Policy expert assays sustainability

Dr. Michel Gelobter, a visiting policy expert in environmental protection, will deliver the next address in Humboldt State University's speaker series, "Sustainable Futures and Energy, the Environment and Society."

Dr. Gelobter is the executive director of Redefining Progress, a U.S.-based non-profit organization working to shift public policy and the economy toward sustainability. His topic at HSU is "The Soul of Environmentalism" and he will give his remarks on Thursday, November 17, at 7:00 p.m. in Founders Hall, Room 118. The presentation and discussion are free and open to the public.



A member of the National Environmental Justice Advisory Council and the Board of the Natural Resources Defense Council, Dr. Gelobter has written extensively about global warming, lead poisoning, commons management, environmental justice, sustainability and the relationship between environmental protection and tourism in developing countries.
